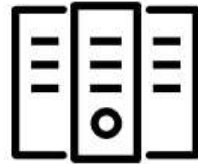
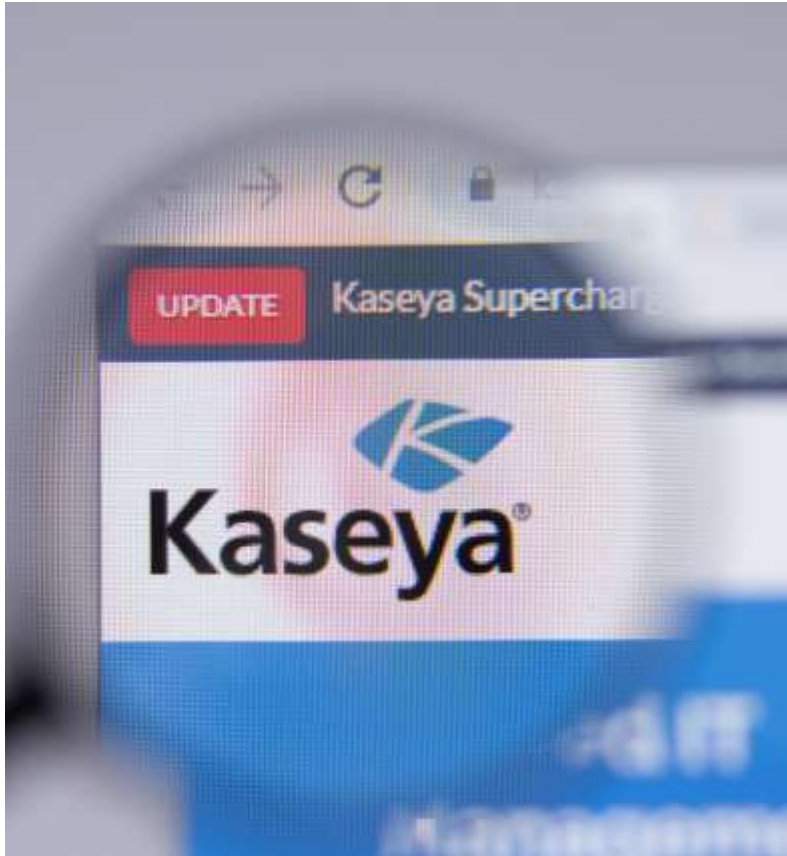

> Step 1 – Be the Leader that Embraces Cybersecurity

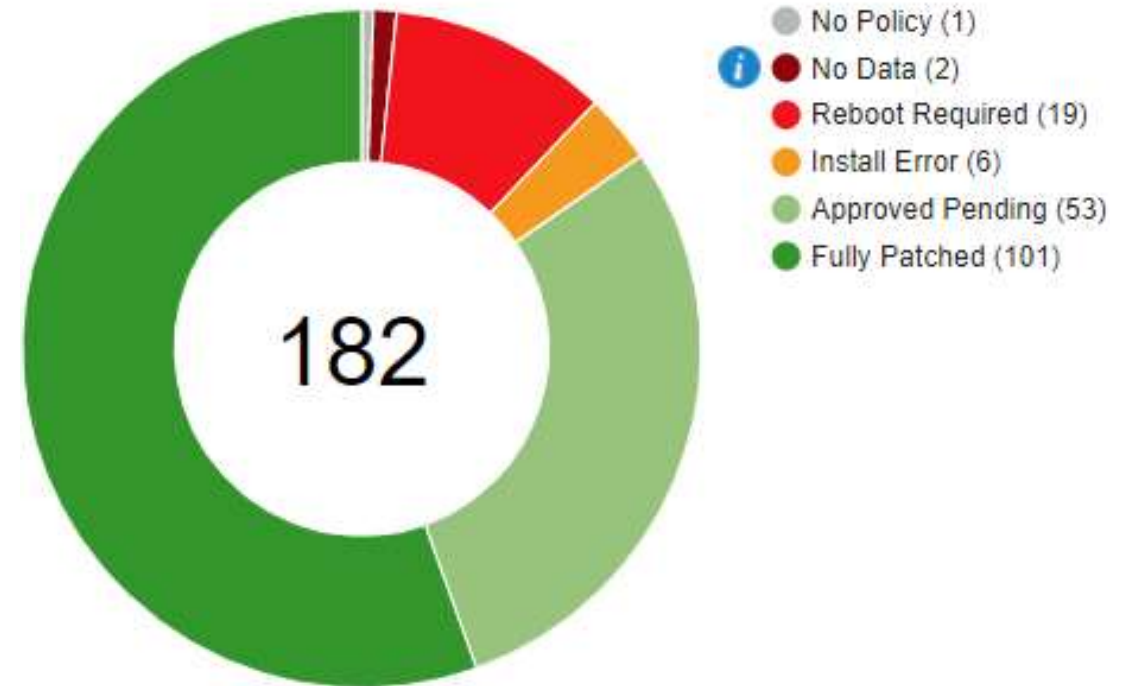
- Educate Yourself
 - What are the Threats & Risks?
 - Do I have any compliance requirements?
- Make Cybersecurity a Priority
 - Put Your Money Where Your Mouth Is
- Buy the Right Cyber Insurance
- Lead by Example – Follow the Same IT Policies & Procedures as Everyone Else
- Require Your Team to Perform Annual Disaster Recovery and Incident Response Plan Testing
- Give IT a Seat at the Executive Table



3 Things Every CEO Should Do NOW

> Step 2 – Verify Basic Cybersecurity Tools are in Place

- Windows Patching w/reporting
- Centrally Managed Antivirus w/reporting
- Only allow corporate-owned devices
- End User Security Awareness Training w/reporting
- Next Gen Firewalls w/reporting
- Microsoft 365 subscriptions
- Disk Encryption for mobile devices w/reporting
- Asset Tracking w/reporting
- Multi-Factor Authentication for Windows, Email, & Cloud
- Off-Site Disaster Recovery



3 Things Every CEO Should Do NOW

> Step 3 – Get to Know Advanced Cybersecurity

- Endpoint Detection & Response
- Managed Detection & Response
- MFA Tokens
- Regular Penetration/Vulnerability Assessments
- Ransomware Protection



Summary

What Every CEO Should Know About Cybersecurity - Summary

- > Cybersecurity threats and attacks are increasing in quantity AND impact
- > There's a LOT at Risk – downtime, loss of revenue, cost of recovery
- > SMB CEOs have to overcome challenges – Top Down leadership, internal IT aren't cybersecurity experts, employees are the weakest link
